

## Adding A Form to a Page

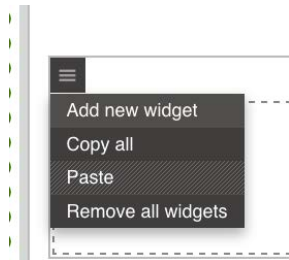
What is a Form?

Forms are a great way to gather information from your customers & also to help them get in contact with you, order product, register for events, or sign up for communications.

Forms are first created in the “Forms” Application. Once a form has been created there, it can be added to the page.

### Adding A Grid Layout for the Form to live in

1: At the top left of the page, press the main hamburger button and select, “add new widget”



2: In the Widget directory—find “ATLAS-Grid Layout”, click on it, and then press the green select button in the lower right of the window. Be Sure to Add 3 Rems of Padding to the top & bottom of the grid layout widget.



You can keep the number of cells as 1—this creates a full width widget across the page. Be Sure to Add 3 Rems of Padding to the top & bottom of the grid layout widget.

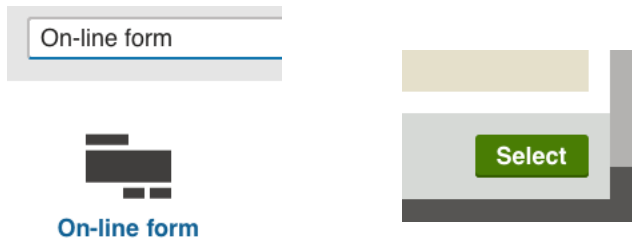

## Adding On-line Form Widget in Grid Layout

1: At the top of your Grid Layout you are working in or just added to the page, press the hamburger button and select, “add new widget”



2: In the Widget directory—find “On-line form”, click on it, and then press the green select button in the lower right of the window.



3: In the window that appears, you will see a “Form name\*” click Select. Then select the form that you would like to use. Last push Save and Close.
