Swine Production Specialist

- Grow the swine feed business and provide profitability to the producer and CFE
- Communicate with the other sales team members and help provide service to the swine system
- Oversee managed barns for CFE
- Grade weaners/feeders when new pigs come in
- Walk through managed barns checking for pig health and barn maintenance
- Mark fat hogs for market
- Work directly with labors of the managed barns
- Maintain high level of competency and goals in the swine feed business
- Work with producers to increase feed business for CFE
- Provide and perform duties as needed to meet goals of the group
- Increase market share and continue positive feedback to CFE
- Assist with coordination of pig flows to current feed customers
- Secure swine facilities to grow CFE feed business

Reporting
